- In 2002, the Rotary Club of Clarenville received funding from ACOA to build a marina





History

- Original Construction starts in 2002









History

- Rotary Marina opens in 2003





History

- Opened with 15-17 boating members
 - approx 400+ linear feet of boats
- Over the next 5 years, the CYC operated and maintained facility
 - Club had grown significantly (40 boats ~ 1200 ft)
 - At capacity



History

- Rotary transfers ownership of the marina to the CYC in 2008
